

Established in 1986, l'Association pour la Danse Contemporaine (ADC) has a mandate to promote contemporary dance and ensure its vital role in Geneva's cultural landscape. Since 2004, ADC is based at Salle des Eaux-Vives.

ADC offers the following:

- yearly programming of contemporary dance events
- developing a dance program within the festival Fête de la Musique
- thematic meetings, conferences with artists, “bus en-cas” transportation to discover dance shows at other venues
- the publication of the “Journal de l'ADC” three times per year.
- a library of documentation on dance, open to the public, containing 500 works on video and DVD, along with ten magazine collections
- network development (local, national, international)
- organization and management of three studios dedicated to research, creation, and rehearsal of dance practices.

ADC manages three studios dedicated to creative work at Maison des arts du Grütli -
16 rue Général Dufour, 1205 Geneva.
